



Exclusion Periods

Medication / Ailment	Exclusion Period
Chicken Pox	5 days from diagnosis or until spots have dried, whichever is longer
Conjunctivitis	Until eye discharge stops or treatment begins
Diarrhoea	48 hours after the last episode of diarrhoea
Scarlet Fever	Until 24 hours after commencing appropriate antibiotic treatment
Headlice	As soon as treatment begins
Impetigo	Until all lesions have crusted over, or 48 hours after commencing appropriate antibiotic treatment
Medication	24 hours after the first dose of a new medication
Vaccinations	No exclusion period unless combined with other symptoms requiring exclusion
Vomiting	48 hours after the last episode of vomiting
Other	Please enquire for guidance

HOW IT WORKS

Our exclusion periods are generally based on governmental guidelines, available on the www.gov.uk website. However, we may enforce stricter exclusion periods if we determine there is a significant risk to the health and well-being of other children, staff, or families.
